The Planning Committee reviewed the above application and all agreed to recommend that it should be supported, however they are disappointed that it be will located outside of the Town Centre as there are premises available within the Town.

## 21/0488/PA Erection of 2 No. Light Industrial/Business Units (B1 Use) (Outline – Landscaping and Layout Reserved) Land to North of Richmond Road, Llanion, Pembroke Dock. SA72 6DY.

The Planning Committee reviewed the above application and all agreed that more information needed to be obtained in regards to the survey that was conducted in 2013. They would like to see an updated version.

Empty units that already existed could be used for this project. The application does not substantiate the need for extra units to be applied.
